Saveun and I send our greetings and hope you are doing well in the Lord's service. We are just beginning to cool down here from the near constant 90 to 100 degree daily heat. This past week it has been in the 80's and we sure enjoy a few months of cooler weather. Typically, it will get down to the 70's for a few weeks in January before heading back up to the 90's.



I had the great joy to give the exams and close out our first year's study for our Bible School. I gave exams to 22 students who have now completed our full coursework in the Gospels of John and Matthew, the book of Ruth, and both Old and New Testament Survey. Included in the work for this school year, (Cambodian public school year is November to November) was a whole series of memory verses and having them recite all 66 books of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation.

Pastor Reap will be in for our Pastor's con-

ference on the 21st of this month and we have already begun preparing and pre-teaching our first class for our second year of study on the book of Exodus. The exam for this class includes having the students describe the ten articles of the Tabernacle, such as the altar of incense, Aaron's High Priest robes and the Ark and mercy seat which rested in the Holy of Holies. They will also need to recite the ten plagues inflicted on the rebellious Pharaoh of Egypt and the ten blessings afforded Israel during their first two years journeying to Canaan. All of this will give them a foundation to understanding the book of Hebrews which we hope to have as a follow-up study.

The Churches are all doing well. We are gearing up today for our weekly Saturday night teen meeting and for the service here on Sunday. Souls continue to get saved and we are always encouraged as God uses us to reach others for Jesus.

We thank you all for your love, gifts and prayers that the Gospel of Jesus Christ may go forward for the honor and glory of our Lord Jesus.
