I have a great report this month that we have reached our goal of being fully set up with our motorcycle needs both locally and for our work in the provinces. I had two incidents over this past year, one involving back pain because my old motorcycle's suspension was inadequate, and the other on my trip in April when a motorcycle struck me from the left side. I hit the pavement and received a large upper arm bruise.
