Greetings from a hot yet rainy Cambodia. Saveun and I hope you are all doing well in the Lord’s work as Summer arrives. We have had some early rains which are a real blessing since things cool down a bit when there is cloud cover.



We were really blessed on the last Sunday of June to see Mr. Hua, the tallest and oldest of our elderly men back in Church. The four men pictured are all back in Church now that the Covid 19 virus is not found in our district. Our four elderly men pictured above from Left to Right are Mr. Vanut age 57, Mr. Savin age 66, Mr. Hua age 72 and Mr. Son Sac age 68. I’m In that age group now also having turned 63 years old this month. Older men here are especially rare. Life expectancy for men in Cambodia is only 67 years of age and I am the only one of six older men on our street to make it past 60 years old. All of the other men on our street passed away in their late 40’s to mid-50’s.



We thought Mr Hua was taken from us in a motorcycle collision two months ago. He was struck from behind by a motorcycle while riding his bicycle and was hospitalized for some time. It was just this past Sunday that he returned still suffering injury to his ankle and with a swollen calf yet back on his bicycle and glad to be back in Church.

It is interesting that just as it was King David’s desire as an elderly gray headed man, so it is the desire of all of us elderly men in the Church today to ask the Lord to keep us around long enough to manifest our strength in prayer, in evangelism, and in faithfulness to the Lord’s service to the generation to come. We all want to see the Lord’s work go forward and to see the name of the Lord Jesus glorified in His Church before we are gone. May God richly bless your love, gifts, and prayers for us so that we may keep the Gospel going forward, even when we are “old and gray headed”.
